SAFETY PRESENTATION - A. Ober, Easton Utilities

Mr. Ober provided an overview of Easton Utilities safety culture regarding all aspects of their excavation crews and work starting with project plans, ticket processing following MD state laws for marks, Ticket Check responses, reviewing their work site for unmark facilities, respecting the tolerance zone, following MOSH standards for trench safety and other work site laws and always excavating with care.

ITICnxt UPDATE

OCC (S. Sullivan) provided information in advance of the December 1, 2022 cutover to ITICnxt for professional excavators using the website portal. Several user notices have been provided to the Delmarva territory in preparation of the cutover. Ms. Sullivan reminded users that they will have one ISITE login for all web services (ITIC 2.0 (legacy) ITICnxt, Search/Status, Ticket Check, Member district reports, Locator Ticket Management, Mapping and to contact the call center for any login concerns.

EXCAVATOR/MEMBER/LOCATING CONCERNS

The meeting attendees discussed the CGA Damage Root Cause report stating they believe next steps to public awareness should include additional emphases on the events after the ticket is processed. Facebook education should be considered.

The Common Ground Alliance (CGA) recently announced the findings from its 2021 Damage Information Reporting Tool (DIRT) Report, and the data indicates that damages have increased since 2019.

The analysis suggests that following challenges in the damage prevention process are responsible for nearly 76% of all damages:

- no notification to the 811 center
- failure to pothole and/or maintain sufficient clearance
- facilities not marked or marked inaccurately due to locator error
- improper excavation practices

"The Report recommends that stakeholders tailor damage prevention efforts and investment to address the specific leading root causes to most effectively lower damages and improve the damage prevention process." To review the report in full, visit;

DE - W. Ericksen (DEPSC) reiterated when to contact the DE PSC for a damaged utility reporting is mandatory under certain conditions since August 2018.

<u>Delaware</u> - Title 26 law change effective August 2018 enforcing mandatory utility damage reporting to the PSC for damage repairs costing over \$3,000 and all gas damages regardless of repair costs.
