#### CALL TO ORDER, WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

- President Lyon called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM.
- The Miss Utility of Delmarva, Mission Statement was reviewed by the President.
- The meeting agenda was presented.
- Robbie Royster from Ditch Witch of VA gave a short presentation about the company.
  Ditch Witch has soft-digging and hydro-excavating equipment ranging from 150-2,400
  gallon. They also are excited to share their new truck at the GCDPTC next week. They
  also make multi-frequency locating equipment with an assortment of features.
- A quick point was made about the One Call Concepts Training Video for Delaware and Maryland. The classes are free and self-paced. They are educational and could be used as a disciplinary measure when a damage occurs.
- Meeting attendance included 31 participants in person and virtually.

There is a Google registration. Register a minimum of two business days ahead for these free training. Interactive online training is available through the website along with several YouTube videos on how to use the system. The demo/sandbox site is still available. Online resources are available 24/7.
